

ACCRA

Ingredients

- ♦ 2 cups flour
- ◆ 1 TBSP Fleischman's yeast
- ♦ 1/2 tsp salt
- ♦ 3 oz saltfish
- ♦ 2 blades chives
- 1/2 small onion, garlic and thyme
- Piece of red pepper
- ♦ 1/2 tsp Black pepper
- ♦ 1 1/2 cups of warm water

Instructions

- Scald fish twice, then remove skin and bone
- Mix fish, onion, garlic, thyme and pepper together into a fine mixture
- Sift flour and salt into a bowl
- Mix yeast with a little of the water and stir it into the flour until a soft batter is formed
- Add fish and blend mixture for 2-3 minutes
- Stand in a warm place to rise for 2 hours
- Fry by spoonfuls in smoking hot oil
- Drain and serve hot with Floats or bakes
