

## **Pumpkin Cream Soup**



## Ingredients

2 cups of pumpkin 1 tomato Piece of carrot, turnip and onion

Sprigs of parsley and thyme

1 Bay leaf

1 medium size green pep-

5 whole black peppers **Grated nutmeg** 

1Tsp salt

es of bacon or ham

4 cups of water or light stock

1 Tbsp flour 1/2 milk

## Instructions

Wash and cut up and cook vegetables (these can be blended if you wish)

Cut up ham and bacon and cook slowly.

Add butter, then lightly fry seasonings and tomatoes Add stock, herbs and salt

Simmer until tomatoes are thoroughly soft

Mix cornstarch with cold water to a smooth paste

2 Tbsp butter or small piec- Add to soup and boil for 5 mins Only add milk and other ingredients once the soup is cooked

> Add seasoning including nutmeg to taste






