# **Soursop Ice-cream**

# Ingredients

- 1 medium-sized soursop (full and ripe)
- A pinch of salt
- 1 tin evaporated milk
- 1 tin condensed milk
- 1 lb sugar

# **Instructions**

- Peel soursop
- Mash in a bowl
- Add 2 glasses of water and a piece of lime peel
