

Steamed Pineapple Pudding

Love to Cook?

Ingredients

- 1/4 to 1/2 cup shortening
- ◆ 1/2 cup sugar
- 1 cup flour
- 2 eggs
- 2-3 Tbsp diced pineapple
- 1 Tbsp pineapple juice
- 1/2 tsp baking powder



Instructions

- Grease a container and dredge with flour
- Decorate the bottom of the container with pieces of pineapple
- Cream the butter and sugar together until white and frothy
- Whisk eggs and gradually beat them into the mixture
- Lightly add and stir in the flour
- Add baking powder with the rest of the pine and juice
- Make sure that the mixture is soft enough to drip from the spoon
- Pour the mixture into prepared container; cover and steam for 1 1/2 hours. Serve hot!
